## **Tournament Committee Report**

### **2009 – 2010 Tournaments**

The tournaments for the 2009-2010 season were bid on at the Annual Convention by club delegates attending, with the exception of the Indoor Championship. This tournament will continue to be maintained by the Association, with written proposals from clubs accepted each year for the venue. The Board of Directors chooses the proposal that is most beneficial to the Association.

There were two agenda items discussed at the Convention regarding making both the State Field and the Outdoor Target Championships one-day tournaments. After much discussion, the agenda item to make the State Field a one-day tournament was withdrawn by the author. The delegates voted to make the Outdoor Target a one-day tournament for a trial period of two years as follows: The Outdoor Target Championship will become a one-day tournament. It will be shot on Saturday and Sunday. The archer may choose to shoot one or both days. If the archer chooses to shoot both days, only the best score will count. The cost of the tournament will be \$25.00, whether the archer shoots one or both days. Awards will be given out after the shooting is completed on Sunday. *[The Tournament Committee has determined that ties will be broken by scoring the last two ends at 60 yards inside/out. Duplicate awards will be given if the archers remain tied on inside/out scoring.]*

**2009 Annual Board of Directors Meeting**  
**Judy McCutcheon, NFAA Director**

This year's meeting was unusually calm with very little controversy – very surprising! The President gave a report on the state of the NFAA, and a Headquarters update. The NFAA attorney, Dave Hosmer, discussed the way our Constitution and By-Laws are formatted as compared to other organizations. The Council has authorized him to prepare a report on a complete revision for review at the 2010 Annual meeting. Doug Ing gave us an update on ASAP – for more information, go to the ASAP website. The new Chairman of the Bowhunting and Conservation Committee gave a report. He is working to fill the Sectional Bowhunting Committeemen and State Bowhunting Director positions. For the Great Lakes, Dave Thewlis will be the Sectional Committee representative, and will work with the NFAA Directors in our section for recommendations for State Bowhunting Directors.

**Agenda Items**

**New rulings will take effect June 1, 2009. I only reviewed some of the more pertinent items. The changes have been posted on the NFAA website and can be reviewed there.**

**Council**

Defeated: Proposal to remove the provision for 15-signature items.

Defeated: Update NFAA dues structure. Our dues will remain the same.

Passed: update to Life membership. Head of Household increased to 20 times the adult annual dues, HOH over 65 increased to 6 times the annual adult dues. Also, a provision will be added to state that in the event of the death of the life member head of household, when both are life members, the surviving spouse will automatically become the Head of Household without charge.

Passed: In the By-Laws, under Article I, General Rules for Field Archery Games, the statement 'the following applies to all Field, Hunter, and Animal Rounds' will be replaced with 'the following applies to all NFAA approved rounds' and a new item will be added that states "No alcoholic beverages may be carried or consumed on any range or practice area during shooting hours at any NFAA sanctioned or owned tournament. Anyone caught breaking this rule will be immediately disqualified and not be allowed to complete the tournament."

**Administration:**

Passed: The Vegas round will be listed as an official round for the indoor sanctioned leagues

Passed: At an emergency meeting called by the President, the weighted 2/3 majority vote must be 2/3 of the full NFAA Board of Directors.

Passed: Updates to the NFAA Certified Instructor program

**Competition:**

Defeated: change the ages of the Senior/Master Senior divisions

No action: add Bowhunter Freestyle to the Master Senior division

Passed: Awards at Sectional and National Tournaments shall be given for 1,2,3 place except where 2 or 3 is the last place in the division or style

**Equipment:**

Defeated: Limit the bow weight to 60 lb.

Passed: Maximum arrow diameter allowed in NFAA competition will be 0.422 inches with point diameter not to exceed 0.425 inches.

Passed: Added the allowance for V-bars in the Competitive Bowhunter division as follows: One straight stabilizer, coupling device included if used, which cannot exceed 12 inches at any time as measured from the back of the bow, V-bar, counterbalance, and string-dampeners, may be used in the Competitive Bowhunter style.

Passed: The maximum peak draw weight allowed in NFAA competition shall be 80 lbs, with a maximum arrow speed of 300 feet per second, with a variance of 3%.
