Secretary Report from Convention.

The IAA board of Directors and delegates meeting was held March 13, 2011 at Ryan Steakhouse in Springfield. The meeting was called to order by the chairman, Dave Woods at 10:10am.

After the pledge of allegiance, roll call of officers was taken with the following present, Chairman, Dave Woods, NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon, northern board, Rick Knorr, Walter Erickson and Bill Berger; central board James Anderson and Bill Mohn; southern board Ron Whitlock, Bill Schuh and Robert Rayhel; NFAA Councilman, Robert McCutcheon. Roll call of delegates was taken with 9 delegates present.

The minutes of the last meeting were passed out to the board members in advance and Ron Whitlock made a motion 2nd by Jim Anderson to accept as published. Motion carried

The financial statement was accepted as printed with a motion by Jim Anderson 2nd by Ron Whitlock. Motion carried.

NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon reported on an agenda item concerning the guest class, after discussion, Judy will submit a new agenda item.

NFAA Councilman, Bob McCutcheon has nothing further to present to the NFAA report but did answer some questions.

The awards committee chairman, Judy McCutcheon reported that they would need to order NFAA patches and championship plaques for the Target and Field Championship tournaments. The convention committee had no report but questioned having the convention at Ryan Steakhouse next year with a date to be announced. There was no report from the RIC, constitution and tournament committee. The youth committee announced that the NASP program championship will be held March 19 at the Orr building in Springfield shooting times of 10am and 12 pm with 340 shooters. Set up time for this shoot will be Friday afternoon at 1PM. Nine bows have been ordered to give away at this shoot. Clubs donating bows were: Joliet 2 bows, Ron's bow shop 1 bow, Panther Creek Bowhunters 1 bow, Prairie Archery 1 bow, Buckskin Legacy, 1 bow. The IAA will purchase arrows for each bow donated. The membership committee made a suggestion that IAA dues be added to the club membership as a way to increase membership.

IAA Secretary, Dixie Garner gave short report on some dates and requirements of charters, bulletin deadline and the e-mail mailing.

A discussion was held on the cost of the awards for the outdoor aggregate and Wally Erickson made a motion 2nd by Jim Anderson to raise the outdoor aggregate by \$5.00 to \$15.00. Motion carried.

A discussion was held by Bill Schuh on the gun raffle. After discussion Wally Erickson made a motion 2nd by Jim Anderson to do the gun raffle with a minimum of 600 tickets to be sold before the first gun is awarded. If all the tickets are not sold then there will be a 50/50. Tickets sales will begin May 1st. The first drawing will be held December 1st. Tickets will be sent to clubs with one member of that club responsible for the tickets. Bill Schuh and Bill Mohn will be in charge of the tickets. Winners of the gun will have the option of taking the gun or 50 % value of that gun. Motion carried

The agenda item on the format for the target championship of a one or two day required participation was discussed. After discussion Ron Whitlock made a motion 2nd by Wally Erickson to extend the trial for another 2 years. Motion carried.

After breaking for lunch at 12PM the meeting was called to order at 1pm.

The next board meeting dates was set for July 9 following the target championship in Pekin, and November 6th with a motion by Robert Rayhel and 2nd by Bill Schuh.

A discussion was held on the bulletin mailing, Paul Schuerings made a motion 2nd by Ron Whitlock to send out notice that all bulletins will be by e-mail or on the web site. Motion carried.

Retired IAA life membership request was granted to Bill Berger on a motion by Wally Erickson, 2nd by Ron Whitlock. Motion carried.

A discussion was held on the income and expenses of the shoots and a motion was made by Robert Rayhel, 2nd by Randy Rutledge to increase the indoor aggregate to \$15.00. Wally Erickson made a motion 2nd by Paul Schuerings to increase all state shoots \$5.00. Wally Erickson made a motion 2nd by Randy Rutledge to increase the split to 60/40. All motions carried.

Mike Lantz was contacted and agreed to fill in as the central board.

Randy Rutledge made a motion, 2nd by Wally Erickson to shoot the Vegas 300 round on the second day of the Indoor Championship for 2012. Motion carried.

The tournament bids were received and the winning bids are published in this bulletin.

Randy Rutledge made a motion, 2nd by Paul Schuerings to host the indoor sectional at 2 locations in Illinois for 2012. Interested clubs can submit a written bid to the Tournament Director by the July Board meeting.

Bowhunting and Conservation committee member Ron Whitlock presented the Big Buck award to Mandel Denmon. The indoor and outdoor aggregate awards will be mailed to the winners.

The secretary position was discussed and Dixie Garner accepted the position for another year.

Jim Anderson made a motion, 2nd by Randy Rutledge to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 2:05PM.

YOUTH HUNT

750 Private Acres

- Youth must qualify June 12th starting at 10 am (Broadheads only)
- Hunt will be on the 6th & 7th of October
- Youth must have an Illinois Hunting License
- All Illinois Laws will apply at both the qualifier and at the hunt

Youth Archery Hunt at the Torstenson Family Youth Conservation Education Center Pecatonica Illinois owned by the Illinois Conservation Foundation

1. Youth must be between the ages of 10 and 17 years of age or 18 and attending high school.
2. All hunters must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult age 25 or older.
3. The TOP ten qualifiers (must be able to put 3 out of 5 broadheads in a 9 inch target at 20 yards) will have a Saturday or Sunday hunt at the TFCYCEC farm formerly known as Deer Yard farm.
4. This hunt is for DOES only.
5. First 3 qualifiers will stay on the farm in the bunk house. Others will camp in the River Center (bring your own cots and sleeping bags or camper trailer).
6. Hunters can hang deer in the farm's walk-in cooler but will be responsible for the processing charges. Or you can donate to Target Hunger.
7. Saturday supper of venison stew will be served at the River Center.
8. Soft drinks will be provided by ICF
9. Tree stands supplied by ICF
10. Trophies for all qualifiers
11. Hats for all qualifiers
12. Illinois Conservation Laws will apply to all participants.

** All hunters will produce a release form with parents signature notarized. If hunter or adult is not comfortable with hunting from a tree stand, ICF will make an attempt to supply a ground blind but the ultimate responsibility is on the hunter.*
