ADDITIONAL RAFFLE INFORMATION

IAA Board of Directors and the members that were present at the convention in March have decided to hold a Gun Raffle to raise money for the organization. This will enable the organization to do more things to promote itself and the sport that we all love.

Tickets for guns are easy to sell Guns go up in value; Bows go down in value and there are a lot more gun owners/collectors out there than archers.

Ticket Prices are \$15.00 each.

Tickets go on sale in May. First drawing will be in December of this year. We have to sell 600 tickets before the drawings will start. If we do not sell at least 600 tickets, it will become a 50/50 drawing.

Guns will not be purchased until after each drawing. Winner may want cash instead of the gun for that month. If the winner chooses the gun, there may be a delay in delivery of the gun due to some shortages from manufacturer according to the firearms dealer we are working with.

Only 2000 tickets will be printed which will increase the odds of winning. Ticket will go back into the bucket for the next drawing so 1 person has the potential to win all 12 guns for an investment of \$15.00.

Bill Mohn and Bill Schuh were appointed at convention to administer the raffle for the IAA.

Club contact will order tickets from Bill Mohn.

Club contact will distribute tickets to club members. They know the members and can better control tickets and money.

Club contact will collect the ticket stubs and \$\$ or checks. Please make checks payable to IAA for amount collected.

Seller puts their name on the back of the ticket stub that they sell. For every 5 stubs that you sell, seller will be put into the drawing once for one \$500 prize.

Each member needs to turn in their sold ticket stubs by the 15th of the month for the next months drawing.

Tickets can be sold to non-Illinois residents. IL residents will require a FOID card to accept a gun. Non IL residents will need to make delivery arrangements with their local FFL gun dealer to receive any guns won.

YOUTH HUNT 750 Private Acres

- Youth must qualify June 12th starting at 10 am (Broadheads only)
 Hunt will be on the 6th & 7th of October
- Youth must have an Illinois Hunting License
- All Illinois Laws will apply at both the qualifier and at the hunt

Youth Archery Hunt at the Torstenson Family Youth Conservation Education Center Pecatonia Illinois owned by the Illinois Conservation Foundation

- 1. Youth must be between the ages of 10 and 17 years of age or 18 and attending high school.
- 2. All hunters must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult age 25 or older.
- 3. The TOP ten qualifiers (must be able to put 3 out of 5 broadheads in a 9 inch target at 20 yards) will have a Saturday or Sunday hunt at the TFYCEC farm formerly known as Deer Yard farm.
- 4. This hunt is for DOES only.
- 5. First 3 qualifiers will stay on the farm in the bunk house. Others will camp in the River Center (bring your own cots and sleeping bags or camper trailer).
- 6. Hunters can hang deer in the farm's walk-in cooler but will be responsible for the processing charges. Or you can donate to Target Hunger.
- 7. Saturday supper of venison stew will be served at the River Center.
- 8. Soft drinks will be provided by ICF
- 9. Tree stands supplied by ICF
- 10. Trophies for all qualifiers
- 11. Hats for all qualifiers
- 12. Illinois Conservation Laws will apply to all participants.

* All hunters will produce a release form with parents signature notarized. If hunter or adult is not comfortable with hunting from a tree stand, ICF will make an attempt to supply a ground blind but the ultimate responsibility is on the hunter.
