IAA Fund Raiser Update for December

WE HAVE A WINNER:

The winner of the December gun raffle was Daniel Mowen from Liberty, IL. The seller of the winning ticket was Mike Lance. Daniel will take the gun instead of cash.

The winner of the January gun raffle was Ken Clayton from Hillsboro, IL. The seller of the winning ticket was Bill Schuh. Ken will take the gun instead of cash.

A total of 1,465 tickets have been sold by 48 members. Total income so far from the raffle and donations is just over \$22,000. There were expenses for printing the tickets and postage to mail tickets, stubs, checks, etc. that came to about \$300. There will be the cost of the guns we give away and the registrations fees for the guns. If all winners take guns instead of the cash option we will clear approximately \$14,000; more if winners take the cash instead of guns. A big THANK YOU goes to all who helped with this fund raiser. The drawing for the \$500 incentive bonus will be at the convention in March; best of luck to all ticket sellers.

Last month I told you the Board wanted me to conduct the drawing each month since I had the tickets. Due to my job requiring me to be away from home, I was not able to conduct the drawing this month so I made arrangements to get all the tickets to Bill Mohn and he took care of the drawing for us. He will continue to conduct the drawing each month. That means as you continue to sell tickets, please send them to Bill Mohn. His address is listed below. Since we are still selling tickets after the drawings have begun, people may not want to pay the full price for tickets so you can discount the price by \$1.25 for each drawing they have missed. This amount will be as fair for them as for those who paid \$15 for 12 raffles because they will still be paying \$1.25 per raffle.

Again, if you have tickets you cannot sell, please return them to me or Bill Mohn so we can get them to people who might be able to sell them.

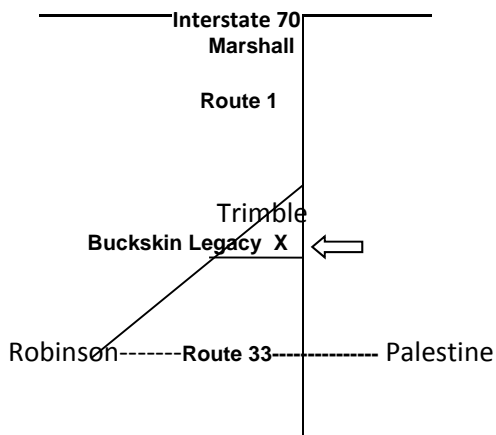
