The IAA Board of Directors and delegates meeting was held March 1, 2015 at the Motel 66 and Convention Center in Springfield following an evening of 5-8 inches of snow. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Robert Rayhel at 10:20AM.

After the pledge of allegiance, roll call of officers was taken with the following present, Chairman, Robert Rayhel; NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon-Adams; northern board, Rick Knorr and Tim Ward; central board, Bill Mohn; southern board Ron Whitlock and Tim Eller. Also present was the past Chairman David Woods. Roll call of delegates was taken by the chairman, Robert Rayhel with 18 present.

The minutes of the last meeting were passed out to the board members in advance and Ron Whitlock made a motion, 2nd by Bill Mohn to accept as published. Motion carried.

The financial statements were accepted as published after some discussion on the expenses for the trophies by a motion from Bill Mohn and 2^{nd} by Rick Knorr. Motion carried.

NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon-Adams gave a report on some of the agenda items that would be discussed at the annual NFAA meeting.

The constitution committee reported that the agenda item to change the constitution will be an e- mail ballot sent out in April.

Bowhunting chairman, Ron Whitlock reported that he didn't receive any applications for the big game awards or team hunt.

The youth committee, Robert Rayhel reported that the NASP shoot would be held March 21 with 1072 shooters. A discussion was held on the donations of bows for the NASP program. Donations of a bow were received from Joliet Archery, Panther Creek, Buckskin Legacy and Judy McCutcheon-Adams. Jeanne Mohn made a motion, 2nd by Tim Eller to donate the bows to the schools not to individual. Motion carried.

The tournament committee held a discussion on clubs hosting the State Field Shoot on a 14 Field or a 28 field. Steve White made a motion 2nd by Ron Whitlock for the clubs to have the option to hold the tournament on a 14 or 28 field. Motion carried.

A discussion was held on the amount charged by our state for the charter fees compared to other states. Bart Loudermilk made a motion, 2nd by Tim Ward to lower the state charter fee by \$25.00. Motion Carried.

A discussion was held on holding an indoor 900 round. The committee will look into finding a location.

Bill Mohn reported that there had been 983 tickets sold for the gun raffle. The names of the \$100.00 prizes for selling tickets were Robert Famulski, Robert Rayhel, Bill Mohn, Dave Potter and Bill Mohn. The Board thanks Bill Mohn and Bill Schuh for all the work that they have done on this project.

A discussion was held on having a marked 3-D tournament, which would be open to everyone. A motion was made by Craig Anderson, 2nd by Bill Mohn to have a marked 3-D. The committee went over some of the rules and decided that this would be a 2 day event and shoot for patches and medals. With an 80-20 split and can be held any weekend in September.

Robert Rayhel and Judy McCutcheon-Adams read a letter of registration from the secretary, Dixie Garner.

The Medal of Merit award (Highest award given by the NFAA) was given to David Woods for his service to the organization.

After breaking for lunch the meeting continued with the tournament bids and the winning locations are listed in the coming events.

The next meeting dates for 2015 were set for June 27 at Pekin and November 1 at Scheels in Springfield.

A discussion was held on a triple crown/shooter of the year. Tim Eller made a motion, 2^{nd} by Ron Whitlock to table until the next meeting.

The secretary position was discussed. After discussion the position was offered to Sara Rayhel at the current salary. Dixie Garner agreed to stay on until maybe June 1 when Sara would be out of school. The board voted to give Dixie a \$500 bonus.

David Woods presented a bid for a new laptop for the secretary and Tim Ward made a motion, 2nd by Bart Loudermilk to purchase the computer for \$1374.25. Motion carried.

IAA Board of Directors and the members that were present at the convention in March have decided to hold another Gun Raffle to raise money for the organization. This will enable the organization to do more things to promote itself and the sport that we all love.

Ticket Prices are \$15.00 each and Tickets go on sale late August.

First drawing will be in January of 2015. We have to sell 600 tickets before the drawings will start. If we do not sell at least 600 tickets, it will become a 50/50 drawing.

Guns will not be purchased until after each drawing. Winner may want cash instead of the gun for that month. If the winner chooses the gun, there may be a delay in delivery of the gun due to some shortages from manufacturers, according to the firearms dealer we are working with.

Only 2000 tickets will be printed which will increase the odds of winning. Drawn ticket will go back into the bucket for the next drawing so 1 person has the potential to win all 12 guns for an investment of \$15.00.

Bill Mohn and Bill Schuh again graciously agreed at the convention to administer the raffle for the IAA. Club contacts or members contact Bill Mohn for tickets.

Club contact will distribute tickets to club members. They know the members and can better control tickets and money. Club contact will collect the ticket stubs and \$\$ or checks. Please make checks payable to IAA for amount collected.

Seller puts their name on the back of the ticket stub that they sell. For every 5 stubs that you sell, seller will be put into the drawing for one of five \$100 prizes. Each member needs to turn in their sold ticket stubs by the 15th of the month for the next month's drawing.

Tickets can be sold to non-Illinois residents. IL residents will require a FOID card to accept a gun. Non IL residents will need to make delivery arrangements with their local FFL gun dealer to receive any guns won.

IAA Raffle Ticket Selling Tips

- 1. Contact your local club raffle contact or Bill Mohn to obtain tickets to sell. Bill Mohn, call 217-725-0836.
- 2. Since the tickets cost \$15, carry a few \$5 bills so you can make change for \$20 bills.
- 3. Ask friends, family and co-workers if they like guns and gun raffles. If they say "no", then ask them if they like cash. There is a cash option for each raffle if they don't want a gun. Show them the back of the tickets for the list of guns and cash options.
- 4. Explain that these tickets are for 12 raffles at \$1.25 per raffle. The winning tickets go back in the cage for the next drawing so all tickets are in all 12 raffles.
- 5. Have the buyer fill out the left portion of ticket so we can contact them. Tear of the right portion of ticket and give to the buyer so they can see what is being given away each month.
- 6. Be sure to put your name on the back of the ticket stub as IAA member. For every 5 tickets you sell, you get your name entered once for 5 drawings for \$100 each. The more tickets you sell the more chances you have of getting drawn for the \$500 cash. Everyone can sell at least 5 tickets and get in on this drawing.
- 7. Mail ticket stubs and a check for the total sold to Bill Schuh, 7811 Dustman Road, Worden, IL 62097. Make checks payable to IAA or Illinois Archery Association.

Notes:

Some people may ask how they get their gun if they live out of state. If people live out of state or don't want to pick up their gun at our dealer in Springfield, IL, they can have the gun shipped from our dealer to an FFL gun dealer near them. Then they can pick up their gun at their local dealer.

Some people may ask if they need a FOID to buy tickets. They do not need a FOID to buy tickets. If they are a winner and live in Illinois and want a gun instead of cash, then they will need a FOID. Out of state winners do not need a FOID.


