# OFFICIAL BALLOT ILLINOIS ARCHERY ASSOCIATION PROPOSED CONSTITUTION CHANGE OFFICIAL BALLOT

## Change article VI number to read:

## ARTICLE VI

## MEETINGS

1. The Board of Directors shall hold an annual meeting as soon as practical a meeting at the annual Convention after the election of officers and the election of the Chairperson of the Board.

2. There shall be a second meeting in conjunction with the IAA Convention.

3. 2. There shall be at least one two additional I.A.A. Board meetings each year. The time and place to be decided by the IAA Board at their annual convention meeting.

4. 3. Special I.A.A. Board meetings may be called by the Chairperson or three members of the Board by written notice to all Board Members with a minimum of ten days notice.

5.4. Action in time of emergency arising in death or resignation of Secretary/Treasurer, Chairperson or N.F.A.A. Director. An emergency meeting or individual contact of each member of the I.A.A. Board of Directors where the entire situation is discussed and decision of the I.A.A. Board is final to fill unexpired term within ten days.

6-5. At no time shall an I.A.A. Board Member be excluded from an I.A.A. Board meeting.

**7. 6**. Five board members must be present to constitute a quorum.

8.7. All IAA members may attend Board of Directors meeting, and may be recognized by the Chairperson, but will have no vote.

## Change article VIII to read:

### ARTICLE VIII

### AMENDMENTS

I. This Constitution may be amended annually at the IAA convention in the following manner.

A. Proposed amendments shall be submitted to the Board of Directors by October 1 July 1. At their November next meeting the board shall, after discussion of the proposed amendment among themselves and securing the agreement of the sponsor for any necessary editing, submit the proposition to the membership, by way of the IAA newsletter, together with statement, pro and con, which may be unsigned. The proposed changes shall be published in the December and January newsletters. The January newsletter will include a ballot by proxy, which must be signed by the voting member and returned as follows: (1) By mail to the IAA secretary, postmarked by February 1, or (2) Delivered to the IAA Convention by a delegate, or in person. The proposed changes shall be published in two consecutive newsletters prior to the annual convention, and returned as follows: (1) Printed ballot sent by mail to the IAA secretary, postmarked within 2 weeks of the annual convention date, or (2) vote emailed to the IAA Secretary prior to the annual convention, or 3) delivered to the IAA Convention by a delegate, or in person. A 2/3 majority vote of those replying shall be needed for the proposal to become an amendment to the constitution.

## Change article II to read:

## ARTICLE II

### ANNUAL CONVENTION

On the last first Sunday of February November each year, or on such other date as may be specially designated for a particular year by the Board of Directors, there shall be a convention, consisting of a meeting of club delegates, representing the IAA Clubs, Pro Shops, and Commercial Lanes. This meeting shall include the Board of Directors and be presided over by the Board Chairperson. Any number of club delegates may attend. Delegates to the meetings may cast I vote for the first 10 I.A.A. members of their club, or fraction thereof and 1 vote for each of their clubs 10 I.A.A. members thereafter to a maximum of 5, as of 30 days prior to the Convention. All delegates must be I.A.A. members but may propose and debate such amendments for later action by the Board and possible membership vote. All questions of POLICY or PROCEDURE not requiring such amendments may be decided by such delegates, provided such question shall have been included in an agenda published in the I.A.A. newsletter prior to such Convention. Agenda items must be mailed to the secretary-treasurer and postmarked no later than October 15.

Delegates will also submit bids for upcoming tournaments as described in Article III The meeting will be followed by a luncheon and awards banquet A meeting of the IAA Board of Directors shall follow.

# Change article III to read:

# ARTICLE III

TOURNAMENTS

1. All I.A.A. Tournaments will be the responsibility of a Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee shall be appointed by the Board Chairperson and shall have at least 1 member from each zone. Some of the responsibilities of the committee will be; to coordinate with the NFAA Director to be sure ranges to be used for IAA shoots have up-to-date range inspections, to work with host clubs to insure that they understand and comply with the requirements for hosting an IAA tournament.

2. Dates for the following year's tournaments shall be determined by the Tournament Committee at the November a Board of Directors meeting prior to the annual Convention.

3. The dates and requirements for bidding on each tournament will then be published in the IAA newsletter, as soon as possible, to give clubs an opportunity to prepare bids for the IAA convention.

4. All tournaments will be bid on at the convention. The delegates at the convention shall vote to award the tournaments for that year.

5. The following is a tentative list of state shoots to be bid on. The Board of Directors have the option of selecting what tournaments to host annually:

State Field Championship State Target Championship State 3-D Championship Youth Tournaments (Indoor, Outdoor, or both) State Indoor Championship (2 days) State Indoor 600 Championship (1 or 2 days, 3 zones) Pro-Am (Indoor or Outdoor (1or 2 days) Some type of combined event

6. No State Championship may be held in the same location 2 years in a row, unless no other bids are received. No club may host 2 state championship tournaments in the same year unless no other bids are received.

7. See the POLICY SECTION for requirements of clubs hosting IAA tournaments.

8. The Illinois Archery Association will not allow advertising in the monthly bulletin against the 4 state championship and any NFAA sectional tournaments held in Illinois.

It's what we used to purchase the State Championship trophies which cost the IAA approximately \$2000.00 for the previous years. This cost previously was taken from the entry fees of each tournament before the club/IAA split. Aggregate trophies are paid for solely by the State Organization. Throughout the year, we have additional expenses. The only other income we get each year is from the State dues and the small percentage we get from the State Shoots each year. Without the previous gun raffle, the IAA could have been out of money and unable to continue. So please take a few minutes and think about this, then get with either Bill Mohn or Sara Rayhel and have them send some tickets to you. We need your help.

The IAA Board of Directors and the members that were present at the convention in March decided to hold another Gun Raffle to raise money for the organization. This will enable the organization to do more things to promote itself and the sport that we all love. Ticket Prices are \$20.00 each and tickets are on sale. First drawing will be in January of 2017. We have to sell 600 tickets before the drawings will start. If we do not sell at least 600 tickets, it will become a 50/50 drawing. Guns will not be purchased until after each drawing. Winner may want cash instead of the gun for that month. If the winner chooses the gun, there may be a delay in delivery of the gun due to some shortages from manufacturers, according to the firearms dealer we are working with. Only 2000 tickets will be printed which will increase the odds of winning. Drawn ticket will go back into the bucket for the next drawing so 1 person has the potential to win all 12 guns for an investment of \$20.00. Bill Mohn and Bill Schuh again graciously agreed to administer the raffle for the IAA. Club contacts or members contact Bill Mohn for tickets. Club contact will distribute tickets to club members. They know the members and can better control tickets and money. Club contact will collect the ticket stubs and \$\$ or checks. Please make checks payable to IAA for amount collected. Seller puts their name on the back of the ticket stub that they sell. For every 10 tickets that you sell, seller gets one free. Each member needs to turn in their sold ticket stubs by the 15th of the month for the next month's drawing. Tickets can be sold to non-Illinois residents. IL residents will require a FOID card to accept a gun. Non IL residents will need to make delivery arrangements with their local FFL gun dealer to receive any guns won. ## IAA Raffle Ticket Selling Tips

1. Contact your local club raffle contact or Bill Mohn at 217-725-0836 to obtain tickets to sell.

2. The tickets cost \$20.00

3. Ask friends, family and co-workers if they like guns and gun raffles. If they say "no", then ask them if they like cash. There is a cash option for each raffle if they don't want a gun. Show them the back of the tickets for the list of guns and cash options.

4. Explain that these tickets are for 12 raffles at about \$1.67 per raffle. The winning tickets go back in the cage for the next drawing so all tickets are in all 12 raffles.

5. Have the buyer fill out the left portion of ticket so we can contact them. Tear of the right portion of ticket and give to the buyer so they can see what is being given away each month.

6. Be sure to put your name on the back of the ticket stub as IAA member. For every 10 tickets you sell, you get 1 ticket free.

7. Mail ticket stubs and a check for the total sold to Bill Mohn. Make checks payable to IAA or Illinois Archery Association.

Notes: Some people may ask how they get their gun if they live out of state. If people live out of state or don't want to pick up their gun at our dealer in Springfield, IL, they can have the gun shipped from our dealer to an FFL gun dealer near them. Then they can pick up their gun at their local dealer. Some people may ask if they need a FOID to buy tickets. They do not need a FOID to buy tickets. If they are a winner and live in Illinois and want a gun instead of cash, then they will need a FOID. Out of state winners do not need a FOID.

Any other type of Big Game Animal NOT commonly found in the territorial boundaries of the United States, but declared Big Game on an INTERNATIONAL LEVEL will be considered for an award, providing that such Big Game was taken legally and is not on the ENDANGERED SPECIES LIST of the U.S. Government, and that the PELT of said animal can legally be brought into this country.

B. That the governing body of this Association will have the right to disqualify any such animal that does not meet the requirements listed in Paragraph A

C. That all Big Game animals submitted for an award be submitted with substantial proof of the kill:

1. That a picture of the animal and the signature of witness, warden, forest ranger, conservation officer

or police officer be present on all applications.

2. If for any reason Paragraph C, Item 1 cannot be complied with, a letter of explanation must accompany all applications giving full details and circumstances as to why.

3. If you hunted with a reputable and licensed guide, a letter of acknowledgment of the taking of any Big Game will be accepted in place of the above mentioned signatures.

D. A PICTURE MUST ACCOMPANY ALL APPLICATIONS.

## BOWHUNTING FAIR CHASE RULES DEFINED:

Any animal taken under any of the following circumstances shall not be considered for any award: "YARDED' IN DEEP SNOW, HELPLESS IN WATER, HELPLESS ON ICE, HELPLESS IN TRAP, WHILE CONFINED BEHIND FENCES AS ON GAME FARMS, ETC., IN DEFIANCE OF GAME LAWS OR OUT OF SEASON. No animal shall be taken by "Jack Lighting"- shining at night from a power vehicle or power boat. Any other method considered by the N.F.A.A. or I.A.A. Bowhunting Committee to be UNSPORTSMANLIKE
