## Board of Directors Meeting

The IAA Board of Directors meeting was held Nov. 5, 2017 at Rt. 66 Hotel and Convention Center in Springfield. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Robert Rayhel at 10:02 A.M. Roll call of officers was taken with the following present; NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon-Adams; Chairman, Robert Rayhel; Northern board, Rick Knorr, Randy Rutledge, and Cassie Flood; Central board, Don Craig, and Kathy Pindell; Southern board Ron Whitlock and Tim Eller. Roger Nieders and Craig Olson were absent. Others attending were Eddie Flier, Mike Flier, Ben McElroy, Dixie Garner, Mike & Genny Vestal, Courtney Langley, Sheila Perkins, Rosemary Chellios, Allysia, Chris, and Amanda Vaultonburg, Ashley, Timothy, Douglas, and Bobbie Kristofer, Austin, Russell, and Lynette Eckert, Nicole and April Weber, Scott Anderson, Rhonda Eller, and Rick Adams.

The minutes of the last meeting were distributed to the board members in advance. Ron Whitlock made a motion, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Rick Knorr to accept. Motion carried.

The financial statements were accepted as published by a motion from Tim Eller, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Judy McCutcheon-Adams. Motion carried.

Director Judy McCutcheon-Adams reported on information from the NFAA. A raise in NFAA dues will take effect on January 1, 2018. Several changes involving class eliminations were approved and went into effect Nov 1<sup>st</sup>. The new president of NFAA is Brian Sheffler from Indiana and new vice-president is Doug Joyce from New Jersey.

Awards committee commended Dave Woods on the new styles of plaques given at the convention.

Constitution committee had written a revision for the change of date of the convention and correlated items and it was accepted by unanimous vote by ballot.

Bowhunting and Conservation member Ron Whitlock said he had received no team shoot applications. Members are encouraged to send in the Big and Small Game Application.

RIC had no new report.

Youth Committee announced the highest overall scoring male and female under 18 years old, following the same guidelines as the adults, will also receive Shooter of the Year buckles for 2018.

Tournament Committee reviewed the new guidelines for the 900 round target face.

Membership and Club Retention committee reminded any youth less than 18 years old that they may join the IAA for a year for \$5 of their initial IAA aggregate or IAA State Tournament entry fee. This is at state level and does not include an NFAA membership nor does it include adult archers who must be NFAA/IAA members to shoot the tournaments for awards.

Chairman Robert Rayhel made the committee appointments for 2018.

IAA Secretary, Sara Rayhel, gave the rates with the \$5 per person NFAA increase. All initial memberships and renewals should be done online at [nfaausa.sport80.com](http://nfaausa.sport80.com) by creating a personal account. Automatic renewals of membership may also be set up. Renewals or initial memberships will be accepted early at the current rate before the first of the year. Beginning Jan. 1, 2018, dues for an individual adult or adult family HOH will be \$65, with \$12 additional for first family member at \$77, 2<sup>nd</sup> additional family member will be \$7 additional at \$84, and 3<sup>rd</sup> or more additional family members will be an extra \$5 each. A family will be \$95 which is HOH, spouse, and all dependents less than 18 years old. Junior individual membership will remain \$20. The increase also applies to club charters which will be \$55 and shop charters which will be \$105. Dixie reminded all the clubs' members that they need to be sure and fill out the portion showing club membership, as charters depend on having 5 heads of household with designated club affiliation.

Tournament bids were accepted for the State Target Championship at Pekin Archery on June 23-24 (note: later changed to July 14-15) and the State Field Championship at Joliet on August 4-5. Written bids for State Indoor Championship are due by July 1, 2018. The 2019 aggregate bids were Joliet (Northern), Havana (Central), and Buckskin Legacy (Southern).

The meeting dates for 2018 are Apr. 8, Aug. 4, and Nov. convention.

Following the meal, Tournament Chairman, Judy McCutcheon-Adams and Chairman, Robert Rayhel presented the 2017 Shooter of the Year belt buckles to Ben McElroy and Genny Vestal. Plaques were awarded to the State Championship and Aggregate winners.

Ron Whitlock made a motion, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tim Eller to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 1:15 PM.

It's what we used to purchase the State Championship trophies which cost the IAA approximately \$2000.00 for the previous years. This cost previously was taken from the entry fees of each tournament before the club/IAA split. Aggregate trophies are paid for solely by the State Organization. Throughout the year, we have additional expenses. The only other income we get each year is from the State dues and the small percentage we get from the State Shoots each year. Without the previous gun raffle, the IAA could have been out of money and unable to continue. So please take a few minutes and think about this, then get with either Bill Mohn or Sara Rayhel and have them send some tickets to you. We need your help.

The IAA Board of Directors and the members that were present at the convention in March decided to hold another Gun Raffle to raise money for the organization. This will enable the organization to do more things to promote itself and the sport that we all love. Ticket Prices are \$20.00 each and tickets are on sale. First drawing will be in January of 2017. We have to sell 600 tickets before the drawings will start. If we do not sell at least 600 tickets, it will become a 50/50 drawing. Guns will not be purchased until after each drawing. Winner may want cash instead of the gun for that month. If the winner chooses the gun, there may be a delay in delivery of the gun due to some shortages from manufacturers, according to the firearms dealer we are working with. Only 2000 tickets will be printed which will increase the odds of winning. Drawn ticket will go back into the bucket for the next drawing so 1 person has the potential to win all 12 guns for an investment of \$20.00. Bill Mohn and Bill Schuh again graciously agreed to administer the raffle for the IAA. Club contacts or members contact Bill Mohn for tickets. Club contact will distribute tickets to club members. They know the members and can better control tickets and money. Club contact will collect the ticket stubs and \$\$ or checks. Please make checks payable to IAA for amount collected. Seller puts their name on the back of the ticket stub that they sell. For every 10 tickets that you sell, seller gets one free. Each member needs to turn in their sold ticket stubs by the 15th of the month for the next month's drawing. Tickets can be sold to non-Illinois residents. IL residents will require a FOID card to accept a gun. Non IL residents will need to make delivery arrangements with their local FFL gun dealer to receive any guns won. ### IAA Raffle Ticket Selling Tips

1. Contact your local club raffle contact or Bill Mohn at 217-725-0836 to obtain tickets to sell.
2. The tickets cost \$20.00
3. Ask friends, family and co-workers if they like guns and gun raffles. If they say "no", then ask them if they like cash. There is a cash option for each raffle if they don't want a gun. Show them the back of the tickets for the list of guns and cash options.
4. Explain that these tickets are for 12 raffles at about \$1.67 per raffle. The winning tickets go back in the cage for the next drawing so all tickets are in all 12 raffles.
5. Have the buyer fill out the left portion of ticket so we can contact them. Tear of the right portion of ticket and give to the buyer so they can see what is being given away each month.
6. Be sure to put your name on the back of the ticket stub as IAA member. For every 10 tickets you sell, you get 1 ticket free.
7. Mail ticket stubs and a check for the total sold to Bill Mohn. Make checks payable to IAA or Illinois Archery Association.

Notes: Some people may ask how they get their gun if they live out of state. If people live out of state or don't want to pick up their gun at our dealer in Springfield, IL, they can have the gun shipped from our dealer to an FFL gun dealer near them. Then they can pick up their gun at their local dealer. Some people may ask if they need a FOID to buy tickets. They do not need a FOID to buy tickets. If they are a winner and live in Illinois and want a gun instead of cash, then they will need a FOID. Out of state winners do not need a FOID.

A. Any other type of Big Game Animal NOT commonly found in the territorial boundaries of the United States, but declared Big Game on an INTERNATIONAL LEVEL will be considered for an award, providing that such Big Game was taken legally and is not on the ENDANGERED SPECIES LIST of the U.S. Government, and that the PELT of said animal can legally be brought into this country.

B. That the governing body of this Association will have the right to disqualify any such animal that does not meet the requirements listed in Paragraph A

C. That all Big Game animals submitted for an award be submitted with substantial proof of the kill:

1. That a picture of the animal and the signature of witness, warden, forest ranger, conservation officer or police officer be present on all applications.

2. If for any reason Paragraph C, Item 1 cannot be complied with, a letter of explanation must accompany all applications giving full details and circumstances as to why.

3. If you hunted with a reputable and licensed guide, a letter of acknowledgment of the taking of any Big Game will be accepted in place of the above mentioned signatures.

D. A PICTURE MUST ACCOMPANY ALL APPLICATIONS.

**BOWHUNTING FAIR CHASE RULES DEFINED:**

Any animal taken under any of the following circumstances shall not be considered for any award: "YARDED" IN DEEP SNOW, HELPLESS IN WATER, HELPLESS ON ICE, HELPLESS IN TRAP, WHILE CONFINED BEHIND FENCES AS ON GAME FARMS, ETC., IN DEFIANCE OF GAME LAWS OR OUT OF SEASON. No animal shall be taken by "Jack Lighting" - shining at night from a power vehicle or power boat. Any other method considered by the N.F.A.A. or I.A.A. Bowhunting Committee to be UNSPORTSMANLIKE

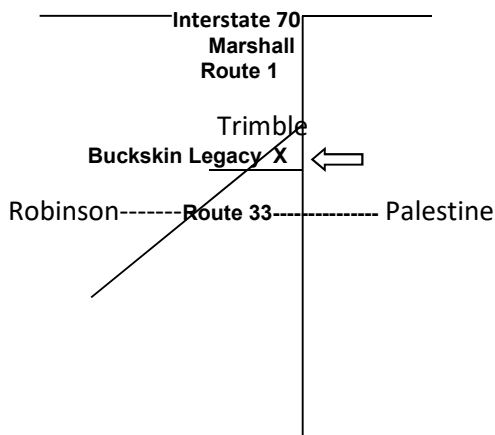

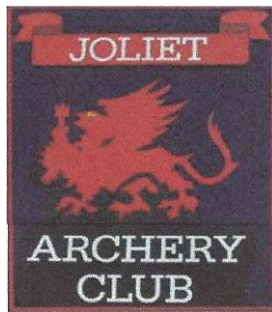
