#### **Board of Directors Meeting**

The IAA Board of Directors meeting was held August 4, 2018 at Joliet Archers following Saturday's conclusion of State Field. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Robert Rayhel at 3:00 P.M. Roll call of officers was taken with the following present; NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon-Adams; Chairman, Robert Rayhel; Northern board Cassie Flood, Rick Knorr, and Randy Rutledge; Central board, Don Craig, Roger Nieders, and Kathy Pindell; Southern board Patrick Eller and Ron Whitlock. Tim Eller was absent.

The minutes of the last meeting were distributed to the board members in advance. Ron Whitlock made a motion, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Judy McCutcheon-Adams to accept. Motion carried. The financial statements were accepted as published by a motion from Judy McCutcheon, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Patrick Eller. Motion carried. The secretary position was offered for another year and accepted by Sara Rayhel by a motion made by Ron Whitlock, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roger Nieders for the same salary and bonus as previous year. Motion passed.

Director Judy McCutcheon-Adams reported on information from the Great Lakes Sectional Board meeting held in June at Panther Creek Bowhunters. There are still problems using the Sport80 website where directors view information. Other problems that are to be addressed by the Council include late publication of the NFAA magazine and sectional awards taking 6 months to be sent out. Dates were reported as follows for the Vegas Shoot (Feb. 8-10, 2019) and (Feb. 7-9, 2020); Great Lakes Indoor Sectionals (Feb. 23 & 24, 2019); Indoor Nationals in Cincinnati (Mar. 15-17, 2019), and GL Outdoor Sectionals (June 16-17, 2019) at Panther Creek Bowhunters. No more than 4 locations in a state may hold the Great Lakes Indoor Sectionals, but the State determines if there will be less. Barebow Recurve will be a new shooting style offered only for The Vegas Shoot.

Rt. 66 Hotel and Convention Center in Springfield no longer has a banquet facility so a motion was made by Roger Nieders, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ron Whitlock to move this year's convention to the Golden Corral. Motion carried.

Awards for State Champions were discussed and patches for Aggregate winners were suggested. Only 2 eligible youth completed State Target and only 1 finished all 3 State shoots so it was recommended that the youth Shooter of the Year belt buckles be discontinued for next year.

Constitution, Bowhunting & Conservation, and RIC had no new reports.

It was recommended dropping the one-year IAA youth membership because there was a lack of participation.

Tournament Committee will let clubs, with bids that are accepted, propose the dates for the State Target and State Field at the convention. An option for State Field to include 28 field/14 hunter/ 14 animal was discussed. A motion was made by Ron Whitlock, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kathy Pindell not to change from 28 field/28 hunter. Motion passed.

Membership and Club Retention had no report.

IAA Secretary, Sara Rayhel, reported it is very important for all NFAA/IAA members to designate an affiliation with at least one or two clubs when they join or renew their NFAA memberships. Club contacts need to update their information with headquarters to include an email address and/or phone number as clubs are not receiving notification of upcoming charter renewals. Commercial advertising in the bulletin suggested price is \$100 per month, \$250 for 3 months or \$400 for 6 months.

The retirement of NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon-Adams, led to her nomination of Robert Rayhel as Director and he accepted. Tim Eller was nominated and Judy McCutcheon-Adams made the motion, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ron Whitlock to elect Tim as Chairman. Motion passed. Judy McCutcheon-Adams will replace Tim as Southern board member and she will continue as Tournament Director.

3 bids were received by July 1<sup>st</sup> for 2019 State Indoor. A motion was made by Ron Whitlock, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Judy McCutcheon-Adams to accept the bid by Patrick Eller for Buckskin Legacy to host the State Indoor at Springfield Archery. Motion passed.

The Great Lakes Indoor Sectionals will be held at Sauk Valley and Buckskin Legacy on Feb. 23 & 24, 2019. Next board meeting is Nov. 4 at the convention.

Ron Whitlock made a motion, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roger Nieders to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 4:09 PM.
